Dear participants,

We thank you once again for the trust placed in IHDC and look forward to meeting you soon. Below we share important information about the camp which will **take place from 19 to 25 July 2025**.

If your child is sick, please contact us before bringing them to camp. Given the large number of children, we cannot take any risk of contagion.

GENERAL INFORMATION

The schedule of off-ice activities and on-ice training will be made available a few days before the start of the camp on the website. You will find the week plan, including assembly and dismissal times, the camp organization chart, a medical form and the authorization for the administration of medication if necessary, which must be handed in at check-in on the first day of the camp.

During the camp, the three main meals of the day will be served to the participants and snacks will be available throughout the week. It is important that participants have eaten before arriving at camp, as they will have two training sessions (off-ice and on-ice) in the early afternoon.

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TO TAKE WITH YOU – THE ESSENTIAL

- **COMPLETE** hockey equipment (see next page) in good condition, rods, freshly sharpened skates, blade protection
- Hockey underwears
- Compeed® or similar (band aid for blisters)
- Outdoor and indoor sport shoes (white or non-marking soles for indoors)
- Sportswear (shorts, t-shirt, training) for off-ice training,
- Shower and bath towel
- Swimsuit, cap, sunscreen.
- Water bottle
- Unihockey stick
- Blackroll or equivalent
- Table tennis paddle with the participant's name written on it, for the regeneration activity
- Badminton racket for those who have one
- In a separate bag for the hotel: necessary to spend the nights, toiletry bag, including warm clothes.
- **IMPORTANT:** Signed authorization for the administration of medication

a) Medical

We kindly ask you to inform us, before the start of the camp, of any intolerance, allergy to medication or food, or if the participant suffers from any illness, such as asthma, allergies, diabetes or other.

We also want to be informed if your child needs special attention (phobia, ADHD, etc.).

The authorization to administer medication must be signed by the parents and given by each participant on the first day of the camp, at check-in.

If your child is taking medication and you would like us to administer it, please write down their name and instructions on the packaging and give them to us on arrival. If your child manages his medication on his own, he will keep it with him.
